Adat Shalom Community,

As Yom Kippur approaches, we want to share a few important reminders to help Kol Nidre and Yom Kippur services run smoothly and securely.

We anticipate over 250 people attending. Please allow extra time for parking and the security check.

- Bring your personalized High Holiday ticket to all services. Your name is printed on the back, and security will verify it upon entry. Please do not share or switch tickets.
- Bring your Mahzor Lev Shalem. A limited number will be available to borrow. Contact the office today if you would like to purchase one.
- Bring your High Holiday pledge card if you have not yet returned it. Contact the office if you did not receive one.

Entrance & Security

- All entry will be through the Chapel Doors in the National Blvd. parking lot.
- The Main Door on Westwood Blvd. and the National Blvd. gate will not be used for entry.
- Security will check tickets and inspect bags, including tallit bags, purses, and backpacks.
- Exit through the Chapel Doors or National Gate. Please do not exit through the Courtyard gates to Westwood Blvd.
- If you have a High Holiday honor, please allow extra time to check in with an orchestrator: Lourine Hall, Jaime Knoll, or Sandra Kass.

Available just inside the Chapel entrance:

- **Kol Nidre, 9/20:** 6:15-7:15 PM
- **Yom Kippur Morning, 9/21:** 8:45-11:00 AM
- **Mincha/Neilah, 9/21:** 5:15-6:30 PM

Seating

Open seating will be available for all services. We anticipate having room for everyone.

Permanent Seat Holders: If you purchased a Permanent Seat and would like it reserved for Yom Kippur, please notify the office by Thursday, September 17.

The front-row pews on the Cantor's side will be reserved for those with High Holiday honors.

Parking

National Blvd. parking lot: Pick-up and drop-off only. Parking is reserved for vehicles with Blue or Red Disability placards. Please pull to the end of the lot when dropping off.

Parking structure: Limited parking is available at 10801 National Blvd., adjacent to the Chevron station.

- **Kol Nidre:** Parking available in the evening
- **Yom Kippur:** No parking during business hours (9:00 AM - 5:00 PM)
- **Mincha/Neilah:** Parking available after 5:00 PM

Please do not park in the Trader Joe's parking lot.

City of Los Angeles - Relaxed street-parking restrictions: Street-cleaning, time-limit, and preferential parking restrictions are relaxed during Yom Kippur on:

- 3000 block of Westwood Blvd.
- Westwood Blvd. between National Blvd. and Pico Blvd.
- Midvale Ave. between National Blvd. and Queensland St.
- 10700 and 10800 blocks of National Blvd.

Parking meters, Tow Away Zones, and other safety restrictions remain in effect.
